

Markdown example with knitr and googleVis

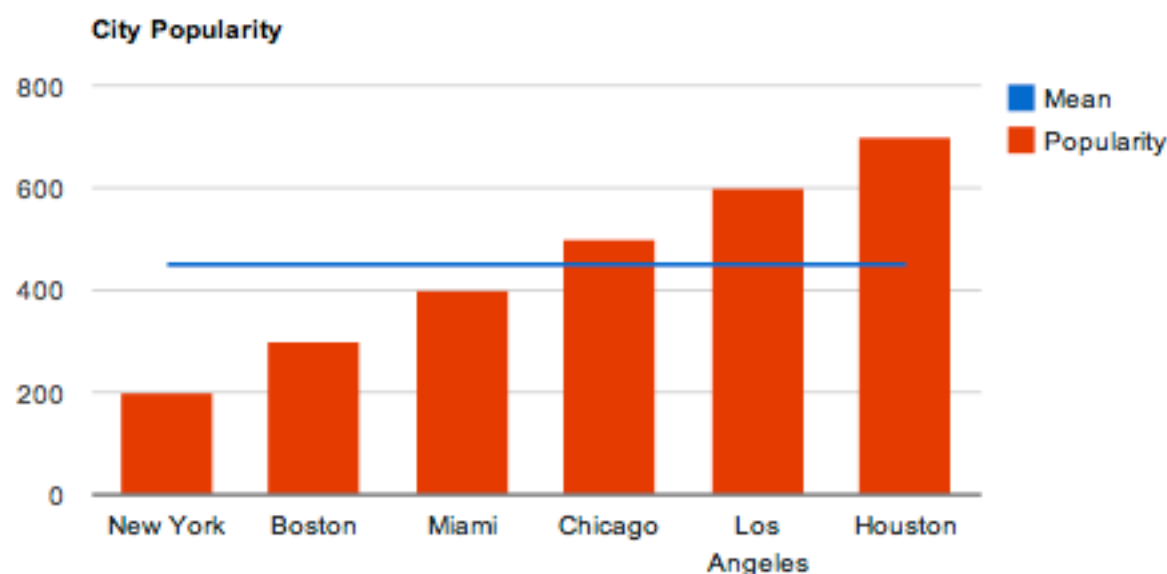
This is a little Markdown example file.

The following plot statements will automatically return the HTML required for the 'knitted' output.

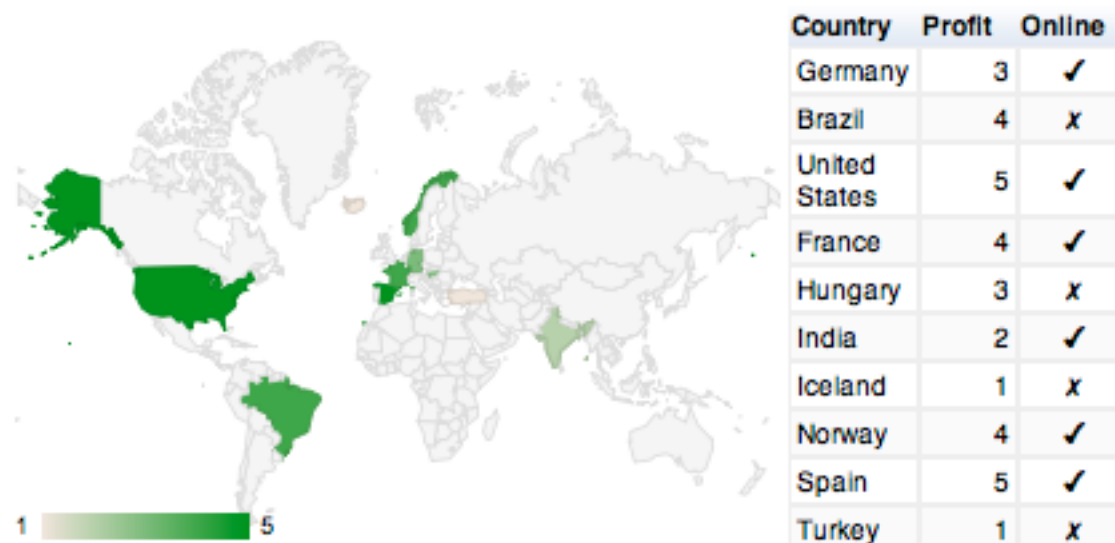

    series='{0: {type:"line"}}'))
plot(CC)
```
